DRAFT SCHEDULE – APPLICATION TO HOLD A SHOW

A TRIAL MUST BE A DOGS A.C.T APPROVED EVENT.

IMPORTANT: Show Secretaries must read these conditions and complete the attached form with sufficient information that will avoid follow up enquiries from the office of Dogs A.C.T, that could delay the process of this draft schedule application.

Dogs ACT Regulation - 8.3 - Approval of a Trial or Event:

- a) An application for the approval of an event (draft schedule) shall be in such form as may from time to time be prescribed by the Dogs A.C.T Council and will include:
 1. The date, venue, type and time of commencement of such event;
 2. Details of the classes in accordance with trial discipline;
 3. Particulars of the judge/s who will officiate at such event, including a copy of the signed judges' contract/s.
 4. All necessary particulars of the event secretary including name, address, phone number and where available email address.
 5. Closing date for entries.
 6. Any special condition that is specific to that event and is necessarily information important to the competitors or participants of that event.
 7. Will include one (1) copy of the schedule in the format for publication in the Dogs A.C.T journal and on the Dogs A.C.T web site.
- b) Affiliates shall submit to Dogs A.C.T Administrator, the draft schedule for their events, parades or other events, on the approved form, at least one hundred and twenty (120) days prior to the allocated date; and the draft schedule is to be accompanied by a fee prescribed by Dogs A.C.T Council.
- c) Special dispensation has been given for Draft Schedule for **obedience** trials; to be submitted at least sixty (60) days prior to the allocated date; but all other conditions of the draft schedule must be met.
- d) If the draft schedule is submitted to Dogs A.C.T Administrator inside one hundred and twenty (120) days prior to the allocated date; Obedience inside sixty (60) days; the draft schedule may still be considered and approved at the discretion of the Dogs A.C.T Council but will be subject to a penalty fee prescribed by the Dogs A.C.T Council.
- e) A schedule may be approved at the discretion of Dogs A.C.T but until a schedule is approved the event is not authorised.
- f) All approved events must be published in the Dogs A.C.T Journal prior to the closing dates of entries. The cost of the publication will be determined by the space required for publication.
- g) Schedules or information related to them must not be distributed or submitted for publication prior to their approval by Dogs A.C.T Council.
- h) Wherever possible affiliated clubs must advise competitors prior to the dates of Events, Trials or Parades of any change to the schedule and the breeds or classes concerned.

@ 1 July 2008

1. An individual draft schedule for each applicable event.
Each event is a different event for the purpose of a draft schedule; where a club runs a multi event weekend (several trials on one day or over several consecutive days) a single ad can cover those events.
2. You must include a show day contact preferably a mobile phone number. This is for the benefit of your judges and stewards.

DRAFT SCHEDULE FEE \$60 INCLUDES 1/3 PAGE JOURNAL AD (\$40)

Full page journal ad = \$98

Half page journal ad = \$57

Two thirds page journal ad = \$65

One third page journal ad = \$40

Where a club requests a full page, half page or allows Dogs ACT to determine the size of the ad, the club will be billed \$20 Draft schedule fee and the cost of the requested/applicable ad.

Whatever the size of the ad placed in the journal will be the same ad on the Dogs ACT web site.

IMPORTANT: The draft schedule application must be signed and dated by the Club Trial/Event Secretary, acknowledging the conditions under the Regulation of Dogs ACT.
