### **Dogs A.C.T Agility Dog of the Year.**

The Rules:

- Competition dates, from 2009 from the 1<sup>st</sup> trial in September each year to and including the last trial in August the year following.
- Entrants: Open to all members of ANKC affiliated bodies.
- Events Eligible: Only ANKC Agility trials conducted in the ACT, by affiliated clubs are eligible to be counted.
- Entry: Five (5) Trial certificates – maximum - to be counted.

Copies of certificates together with application for the competition must be received by or on the 15<sup>th</sup> September in the year of the competition. Originals may be requested for confirmation at any time.

The Placing of the dog (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> etc to 10) which must be visible on the front of each certificate and the certificate must be signed by the judge.

Certificates which do not include the Placing or the signature will not be accepted.

Scoring of the certificates will be 'Normalised' by awarding 1 point to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2 points to 2<sup>nd</sup> etc to a maximum of 10. Therefore five (5) 1<sup>st</sup> places will achieve a score of five (5) points. Other scores will be rated at a lower priority than this score.

Applications which include less than 5 valid certificates, will have the missing scores attributed 10 points each.

#### **The Event Competition:**

The top 20 (or more if equal scores exist) will be accepted as entrants to compete in a suitable event to contest for the ACTCA Agility Dog of the Year.

The event will be a course based on open standard challenges with 12 weave poles but without the seesaw and will consist of up to obstacles.

The course will be designed under the control of the Agility Sub-Committee.

#### **Prize:**

The winner will receive a trophy and ribbon and will be named ACT Agility Dog of the Year.

## **Dogs A.C.T Jumping Dog of the Year.**

### The Rules:

- Competition dates, from 2009 from the 1<sup>st</sup> trial in September each year to and including the last trial in August the year following
- Entrants: Open to all members of ANKC affiliated bodies
- Events Eligible: Only ANKC Agility trials conducted in the ACT, by affiliated clubs are eligible to be counted
- Entry: Five (5) Trial certificates – maximum - to be counted

Copies of certificates together with application for the competition must be received by or on the 15<sup>th</sup> September in the year of the competition. Originals may be requested for confirmation at any time.

The Placing of the dog (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> etc to 10) which must be visible on the front of each certificate and the certificate must be signed by the judge. Certificates which do not include the Placing or the signature will not be accepted.

Scoring of the certificates will be 'Normalised' by awarding 1 point to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2 points to 2<sup>nd</sup> etc to a maximum of 10. Therefore five (5) 1<sup>st</sup> places will achieve a score of five (5) points. Other scores will be rated at a lower priority than this score.

Applications which include less than 5 valid certificates, will have the missing scores attributed 10 points each.

### **The Event Competition:**

The top 20 (or more if equal scores exist) will be accepted as entrants to compete in a suitable event to contest for the ACTCA Agility Dog of the Year.

The event will be a course based on open standard challenges without the weave poles and will consist of up to 24 obstacles.

The course will be designed under the control of the Agility Sub-Committee.

### **Prize:**

The winner will receive a trophy and ribbon and will be named ACT Jumping Dog of the Year.
