ACT AGILITY AND JUMPING JUDGES TRAINING SCHEME

Dogs A.C.T is seeking applications for participants for Agility and Jumping Judges training.

Members of Dogs ACT who aspire to become an Agility and Jumping Trial judge must, at the time of application, meet the following requirements:

- Have been a member of the ACTCA (Dogs ACT) or another controlling body for 5 years and be a current ACTCA member.
- Be at least 21 years of age.
- Be a resident in the ACT.
- Have trained and trialed a dog to the minimum standard of Agility Dog.
- Been an active instructor in the sport of agility for 2 years.
- Recognition of equivalent experience and/or qualifications as approved by Council on the recommendation of the Agility Sub Committee.
